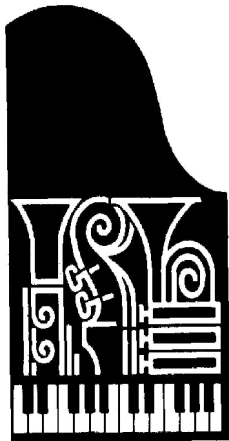


# Young Artists Competition

## PURPOSE

To encourage and foster the development of young musicians in northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan

Competition attendance is free and open to the public. Teachers, family, and friends are encouraged to attend.

## ELIGIBILITY

Piano, string, woodwind, brass, and percussion students enrolled in grades 6 through 12 on the competition date and living within the area served by The Toledo Symphony are eligible. Previous winners may not apply on the same instrument.

## AWARDS

Each of the three winners will appear as a soloist with The Toledo Symphony at one of the orchestra's public performances and will receive a \$350 cash prize at the time of their performances

## FEE

An entry fee of \$25.00 (nonrefundable) must accompany the application form. Checks should be made payable to The Toledo Symphony League

## RULES

1. Applications must be postmarked no later than Monday, April 6, 2009 and should be sent to:

2. The applicant must perform one movement of a concerto from the required list, not to exceed 8 minutes, and an additional short solo work of contrasting style, not to exceed 7 minutes. Total amount not to exceed 15 minutes. Selections may not be heard in their entirety. Each must be performed from memory.

4. Each applicant will be acknowledged by mail. Applicants who are accepted will be given an exact audition time.

5. Each applicant will be identified only by number during the audition.

6. A jury of three judges will be assigned by The Toledo Symphony League and will include an artistic representative of The Toledo Symphony. The judges may choose fewer than three winners if, in their judgment, qualified soloists have not been heard. The decision of the judges will be final.
