

## Toledo Symphony League's Young Artist Competition

The purpose of the Toledo Symphony League's Young Artist Competition is to foster the development of young musicians in Northwest Ohio and Southern Michigan.

### Competition

**Date:** Saturday, May 23, 2020

**Time:** Auditions begin at 9am

**Place:** University of Toledo Center for the Performing Arts (1910 West Rocket Drive, Toledo, Ohio)

### Eligibility

- Piano, string, woodwind, brass, and percussion students who will be 18 years old or younger on the day of the competition.
- Students must reside in counties served by the TSO. The following counties in Ohio are included: Defiance, Fulton, Hancock, Henry, Lucas, Ottawa, Paulding, Putnam, Sandusky, Seneca, Wood, and Williams. The following counties in Michigan are included: Hillsdale, Lenawee, and Monroe.
- Previous Toledo Symphony League Young Artist Competition winners may not apply on the same instrument.

### Awards

- Each of the winners must appear as a soloist with the Toledo Symphony at one of the TSO's public performances.
- Winners will receive a \$1000 award at the time of his or her performance.
- One winner will be given the Claudia Trombla Memorial Scholarship award, named after Mrs. Trombla in memory of her long-time dedication to the Young Artist Competition.

### Fee

An entry fee of \$25 (non-refundable) must be submitted before an audition time will be secured. Check or money order, made payable to the Toledo Symphony League, should clearly state the applicants name and be mailed to:

### Guidelines

1. Applications will be completed on-line. The form can be found at <https://forms.gle/4mK2C8Xo4pn6ZKmW9>. Registration closes at 11:59pm on May 8, 2020. Prior to filling out the form, please have the following information: school address, collaborative pianist's name, list of previous teachers, awards received, and noteworthy performances.
2. Applicants will perform one movement of a concerto from the recommended repertoire not to exceed eight minutes, and an additional short solo of **contrasting style** not to exceed seven minutes. Some selections may not be heard in their entirety. All repertoire is subject to approval.
3. Applicants who are accepted will be sent a specific audition time via email and/or telephone by May 12, 2020.
4. Applicants must plan to be accompanied by a pianist of their choosing at their own expense.
5. Memorization of the music is not required.
6. Applicants are required to bring three copies of their chosen selections for the judges with measures numbered. Upon check-in, applicant will provide an **original** purchased copy of the music. Out of respect for copyright laws, all photocopies will be shredded after the audition.
7. The jury of judges, chosen by the Toledo Symphony, may choose up to three winners. The decision of the judges will be final.
8. All students will receive written comments from the panel of judges.
